What: During December and January, many religions celebrate festivals of the coming of the light. Among them are: Solstice, Chanukah, Ramadan, Christmas, Kwanzaa, and Divali.

At Heart To Hand School, we enjoy a celebration that matches the universal experience of this season, of moving from darkness to light.

The Advent Spiral is a spiral path of evergreen boughs that is, at first, blanketed in near darkness and quiet. Each student in turn walks the path carrying an apple with a candle in it.



Lighting their candle from the lit candle in the center of the spiral, the students carefully walk back out of the spiral, placing their candle somewhere on the path to increase the illumination. The celebration begins in darkness and ends brightly lit by many candles.
